


Smells Like Teen Spirit by Nirvana - Solo

tablature



The tablature consists of four systems, each with two staves (T and B). The first two systems are identical and show a sequence of notes: 10, 8, 10, 6, (6), 8, 8, 6, 5, (5), 6, 5, 8, 6, (6), 8, 8, 6, 5. The third system includes slurs and slides (sl.) over notes like (5) 6 5 6 5, (5) 6 5 6 5 5 3, (3) 6 5 6 5, and (5) 6 5 6 5 5 3. The fourth system shows (3) 6 5 6 5 and (5) 6 5 6 5 5 3.

tips

- As well as being a great song for learning how to play power chords this 1991 Nirvana classic also contains a fairly simple solo for guitarists starting to look at lead guitar and soloing.
- It mainly uses the Fm pentatonic scale but for this particular solo it is best not to worry too much about the scale behind it as it doesn't really stick to a specific pattern/shape.
- Watch out for the tied () notes. These are not to be played again - it just means the note carries over into the next bar.
