


Wish You Were Here by Pink Floyd - Intro Solo

- Released in 1975 this brilliant David Gilmour acoustic solo is another must know solo for those learning lead guitar. It utilises bends, pre-bends, pull-offs and double stops.
- It uses the G major pentatonic scale but if you haven't learnt major pentatonic yet you can think of it in the relative minor of Em pentatonic, pattern 1 and 2.
