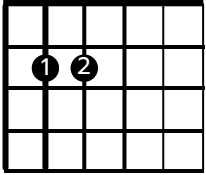


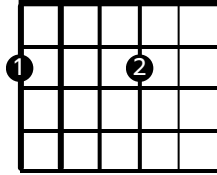
# Horse With No Name by America

## chord progression

**Whole song: Em | D6/F#**

## tips

- This classic song is great for beginners as it uses the same 2 chords, alternating between them for each bar throughout the whole song.
- The first chord is an Em which you will find in many songs. The second is a D6/F# - also called D6/9 - which is fairly unique to this song.
- To transition between chords all you have to do is move your first finger (1) back and forth between the A and low E string on the 2<sup>nd</sup> fret, with your middle finger (2) moving between the D and G strings 2<sup>nd</sup> fret.
- As the song is in 4/4 time you count to 4 for each bar before changing chord. If you are just starting out this means you can strum one down strum each time you say a number - so 4 down strums each bar before changing chord.
- To sound more like the original version of this song we can incorporate a swing/shuffle feel. When you have some experience strumming ask your tutor to show you how to do this.
