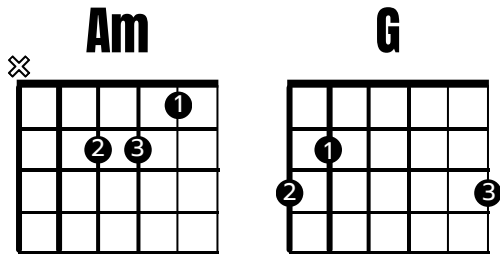


Drunken Sailor Traditional

chord progression

Whole song: Am | G | Am | G - Am

tips

- This sea shanty dates back to almost 200 years ago and is an easy and fun to play 2 chord song that repeats the same chord progression throughout.
- Like most of the beginner songs you will look at this song is in 4/4 time meaning there are 4 beats in each bar.
- Start off by strumming 4 down strums each bar as you count the numbers and as your strumming improves you can start to add some up strums.
- Note that the final bar of the progression contains both a G and an Am in it. The G gets the first 2 beats of the bar and the Am the last 2 beats.
