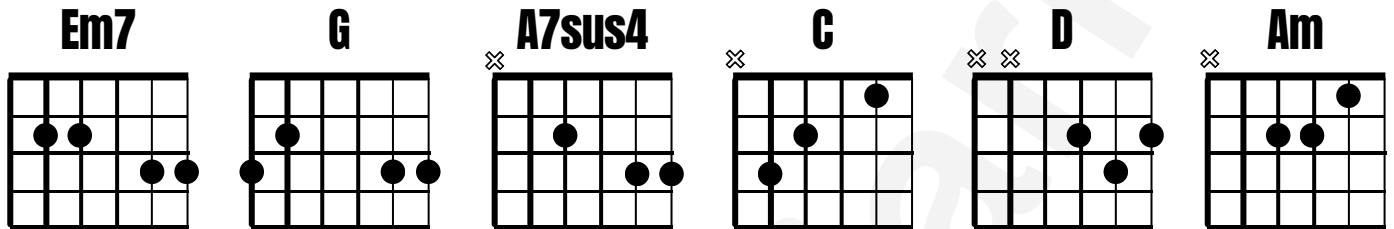

intro tab

tips

- This must know song for guitarists features an iconic intro progression and acoustic solo.
- The tab above is a guide to the intro showing the single notes lines and the chords underneath them. When you are able to put both the chords and lead-in lines together add more light strums to the chords focusing on the treble strings.

- The verse is fairly straightforward in comparison but one way to embellish it is to use a C/G chord instead of the standard C. To do this simply hold a normal C and then move your ring finger to the 3rd fret of the low E string (a G note) and place your little finger where your ring finger was on the 3rd fret of the A string.
- For tabs on the acoustic intro solo see our section on solos.
