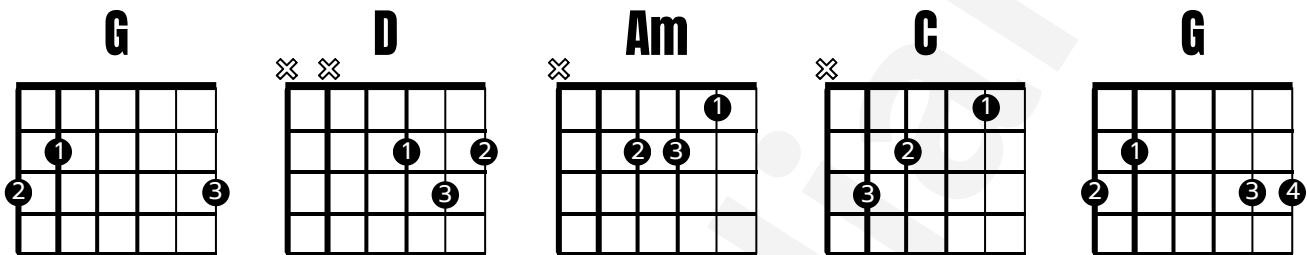


Knockin' On Heaven's Door by Bob Dylan

tips

- This 1973 song by Bob Dylan and famously covered by Guns N' Roses is a great song for students moving on from 2 chord songs.
- The chord progression stays the same throughout with the 1st bar being a G to D movement and then alternating between ending with a full bar of Am or C.
- This song is also a good one for trying out a popular alternative to the basic G chord voicing by holding the 3rd on the B string as well as top E.
- To sound like the Guns N' Roses version then you need to detune the guitar to Eb instead of standard tuning. This means each string is tuned down a half-step to Eb, Ab, Db, Gb, Bb, Eb. It also does not use the Am and ends each 2 bar pattern with just the C chord.
