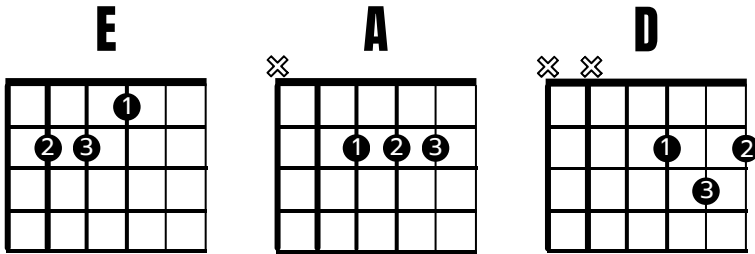

tips

- This 1967 song is a great introduction to the E, A and D major chords, 3 chords that when combined have produced some of the most famous songs ever written.
- Given it's fairly slow pace you have plenty of time to make the changes and it sounds great even just strumming each chord once per bar throughout the verse and intro parts.
- This song is in 4/4 time so count to 4 each bar.
